Charles COPPOLANI, ARJEL Chairman, and Teresa MONTEIRO, SRIJ Vice Presidente, signed a bilateral cooperation and information exchange agreement on 26 January 2016.

This agreement formalizes the fruitful collaboration built during the last years between both authorities which share a common approach of gambling regulation.

The agreement is intended to support controls achieved by ARJEL and SRIJ with regard to the fight against illegal gambling, the fight against fraud and money laundering, as well as to consumer protection and integrity of online betting.

While enabling operational exchanges, this bilateral cooperation agreement complements the general framework of the Cooperation Arrangement concerning online gambling services dated November 2015 which gathers the declarations of intent of the gambling regulatory authorities of the EEA Member States.
